METHODOLOGY:

The training will involve presentation on aforementioned topics with emphasis placed on hands-on sessions for skill based topics. Each trainee will be required to practice practical skills like checking vital signs, performing CPR, dressing and bandaging, and transportation of accident victims. Training sessions will also involve interactive and experience sharing sessions for ensuring that the knowledge shared is comprehended in the context of its applicability for the trainee. A trainer - trainee ratio of 1:12 will be maintained.

CERTIFICATION:

“After the completion of training, the trainees will be required to give a post-training test. Those passing with 50% will be able to secure e-certificate as being trained by Lifeline Foundation, a recognized First Aid Training institution by Director Industrial Safety and Health, GoG within 7 days of the training date. The certificate issued is valid for 2 years from the date of issue.”

Note: Certificate will be issued to those candidates whose fee has been received.
